All submitted papers in English can be published after the conference in special journal <u>SHS Web of Conferences</u> (publishing house EDP Sciences – France), indexed in Web of Science database.

Papers submitted for publication should address one of the topics listed in the call for papers and must both meet the general criteria of the conference and reflect the personal results of the researches, including any special requirements governing format, novelty, and originality. Before submitting your papers please ensure that it has been carefully read for typographical and grammatical errors.

Papers are submitted for consideration by filling in the questionnaire on this site in the "Registration" section as a doc/docx format till September 20, 2020.

Style Guidelines for Conference Papers:

1. The number of the authors must not exceed three people.

2. Two articles are the maximum amount of the papers submitted by an author.

- 3. The final length of the research paper is 4-8 pages.
- 4. Image resolution is at least 300 dpi.
- 5. Self-citation beyond 30%

6. All listed references must be cited in the text. The list of references should be alphabetically, and numbered serially. The recommended amount of references from 20 to 30 references (the numeration is successive in the text and references according to the mentioning). While presenting the results of the research and referencing, it is not allowed to use educational and educational-methodological literature, manuscripts (thesis and author's abstracts of dissertations). These documents have to be relatively recent, relevant and easily accessible. It is desirable for documents to be accessible via the Internet.

7. Due to internationalization, collaboration with the foreign colleagues to have the foreign co-authors is encouraged!

Articles must be typed in the corresponding journal template and have the following main elements:

1) statement of the problem in general form and its connection with important scientific and practical tasks;

2) analysis of the latest achievements and publications in which the solution of this problem has been started, highlighting of the previously unresolved parts of the general problem to which this article is devoted;

3) formulation of the goal and setting the tasks of the work;

4) presentation of the main research material with full justification of the scientific results obtained, formulation of recommendations;

5) conclusions on this study and prospects for its further development.

The article design template is presented in Appendix 2

Organization fee:

Organization fee – 9 000,00 rub.

The organization fee includes publication in the journal <u>SHS Web of</u> <u>Conferences</u>, access to all meetings of the conference, a participant's set (a folder, a pen, a notebook, a badge, a certificate of Presentation/Attendance), coffee breaks, information support.

The standard fee does not include meals, accommodation and transportation expenses of the conference participants.

For the additional fee, excursions around Yalta and Crimea will be organized for the participants of the conference. In case of necessity, all additional expenses can be included in the fee.

The fee is valid only after the notification of paper submission into the conference program, but the deadline is October 1, 2020.

In case of a significant change in the ruble exchange rate relative to the euro, the organizing committee reserves the right to change the amount of the fee for the English-language publications, but not later than October 1, 2020.
